As part of our residential care package, we assist with daily living activities such as, dressing, bathing, laundry, toileting, medication and providing nutritional meals.

Our respite programme provides short-term breaks for families and other unpaid caregivers of elderly people, allowing them to take a much-deserved holiday without having to be worried about the care of a loved one.

Our Home

Our home has a warm, contemporary ambiance with a touch of character to remind us of our pastimes.

Our residents have the option to relax within our communal areas which are equipped with the latest comforts and amenities and are overlooking our beautiful gardens.

Depending on the individuals' personal financial situation, a resident can either pay the fees privately or receive benefits arranged by social services.




